

**Roadrunner Region
Governor's Meeting
September 29, 2006**

Carl McFadden, Regional Executive, called the meeting to order at 5:10 P.M.

Roll Call was taken by Nancy McFadden, Secretary. 7 Governors were in attendance. 6 Clubs were by Proxy, 2 Clubs, Roadrunner Corvettes and Sonoran Desert Corvettes were absent. (No Proxy).

Ken Daby made a special announcement that he bought a yellow 06.

Regional Minutes: A motion was made by Ken Daby to accept the Minutes for the May 26th meeting.. Paul Hamersly seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Regional Treasurer's Report: Ken Daby

Ken passed out copies of the current treasurer's report. Balance for the May 26th, 06 was \$4,384.67. Balance for the period 5/26/06 through 9/29/2006 was \$4,546.60. A Motion was made by Paul Hamersly to accept the Treasurer's Report as read. The motion was seconded by Dale McKeeman.

Regional Competition Report: Paul Hamersly, RCD

Paul handed out a RCD Report to those in attendance. The report included a breakdown of items that are being worked on by the National Competition Committee, which met on Sept. 6th. There was a discussion on the different points mentioned in the report. The report also included the Roadrunner Region Standings as of 9/22/06 and a point standing by Club Participation factored by percentage of participation by members.

There was a discussion for the need of Ambulances and Wreckers at events. Low speed will not require ambulances/wreckers. They are too expensive.

There was a discussion of Chance Rally's. It was suggested that there be a clarification on Chance Rally's. Skill factor should be in consideration.

A question was brought up about a car entering a car show, when it is apparent the owner has not made an attempt to clean it. Should that car be allowed to enter. It was discussed and decided that not one should be kept out of a car show.

It was also noted that the Rule Book says you have to enter the lowest class your car is legal for. There was a discussion on this point.

Paul thanked everyone for their input and said he would take their comments back to the next meeting.

Regional Membership Director Report: Ron Scott, RMD.

Ron said the NCCC Dues are due to him by November 13th. He would accept the 13th as a postmark.

He asked that everyone please get in any address changes. He said that National was still trying to go electronically for membership.

He also asked that the Governor's make sure there is a signature on the application.

There was a discussion on "When are you a member of NCCC". As of now, it is still, you are not a member until you are given a number.

The Governor's asked Ron to relay their feelings to National. As soon as a Club gets their money they should be a member. The discussion continued.

Announcements:
